



WATER RESOURCES FACULTY POSITION UNIVERSITY OF MARYLAND

University of Maryland, Department of Civil and Environmental Engineering seeks applicants for two (2) tenure-track positions in water resources engineering, hydrology, and hydraulics at the assistant or associate professor level. Appointments at the full professor level will be considered. Candidates are expected to possess strong academic teaching skills, to demonstrate scholarly research, and to obtain funding from competitive external funding agencies. All areas of water engineering and planning will be considered.

All applicants must hold a PhD in Civil Engineering or a related field by January 2010 for appointment in spring 2010, or by September 2010 for appointment in fall 2010.

For best consideration applications should be received by November 30, 2009 for spring appointment; and by January 31, 2010 for fall appointment, but later applications will be reviewed.
